NO ILLEGAL DUMPING OF WASTES

Any person who commits an offence may be subject to a maximum fine of \$200,000 and 6 months imprisonment upon conviction.

The Hong Kong Special Administration Region commits tremendous sums to handle large volumes of domestic, commercial and industrial wastes every year. Illegal dumping of wastes on remote hillside or by the roadside would not only bring about pollution, but also cost the Government additional resources to remove it.



The following Landfill Sites are managed by the Environmental Protection Department and receive solid wastes from households, industrial and commercial activities and organic wastes such as bamboos, timber and packaging wastes, etc. arising from construction or demolition works.
