

## FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

(Notification under section 5)

PROPOSED NEW SUBMARINE GAS PIPELINE TO BLACK POINT  
POWER STATION, TUEN MUN

Notice is hereby given that the undertaking described in the Schedule below is proposed. A copy of the plan delineating and describing the proposed undertaking and the foreshore and sea-bed to be affected thereby has been prepared and may be inspected by the public free of charge on the Lands Department website ([www.landsd.gov.hk](http://www.landsd.gov.hk)) under Government Notices, at the Lands Department Survey and Mapping Office, 23rd Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong (where copies can be purchased on order) and at the Tuen Mun District Office, Public Enquiry Service Centre, 2nd Floor, Tuen Mun Government Offices, 1 Tuen Hi Road, Tuen Mun, New Territories during the following hours:—

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over the foreshore and sea-bed so described may, by notice in writing delivered to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of two months from the date of this notice, object to the proposed undertaking. The notice of objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he alleges he will be affected.

## SCHEDULE

*Foreshore and sea-bed affected*

Approximately 49.1 hectares of foreshore and sea-bed from the northwest boundary of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) waters to Black Point in Tuen Mun as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered TMM3131, deposited in the Land Registry.

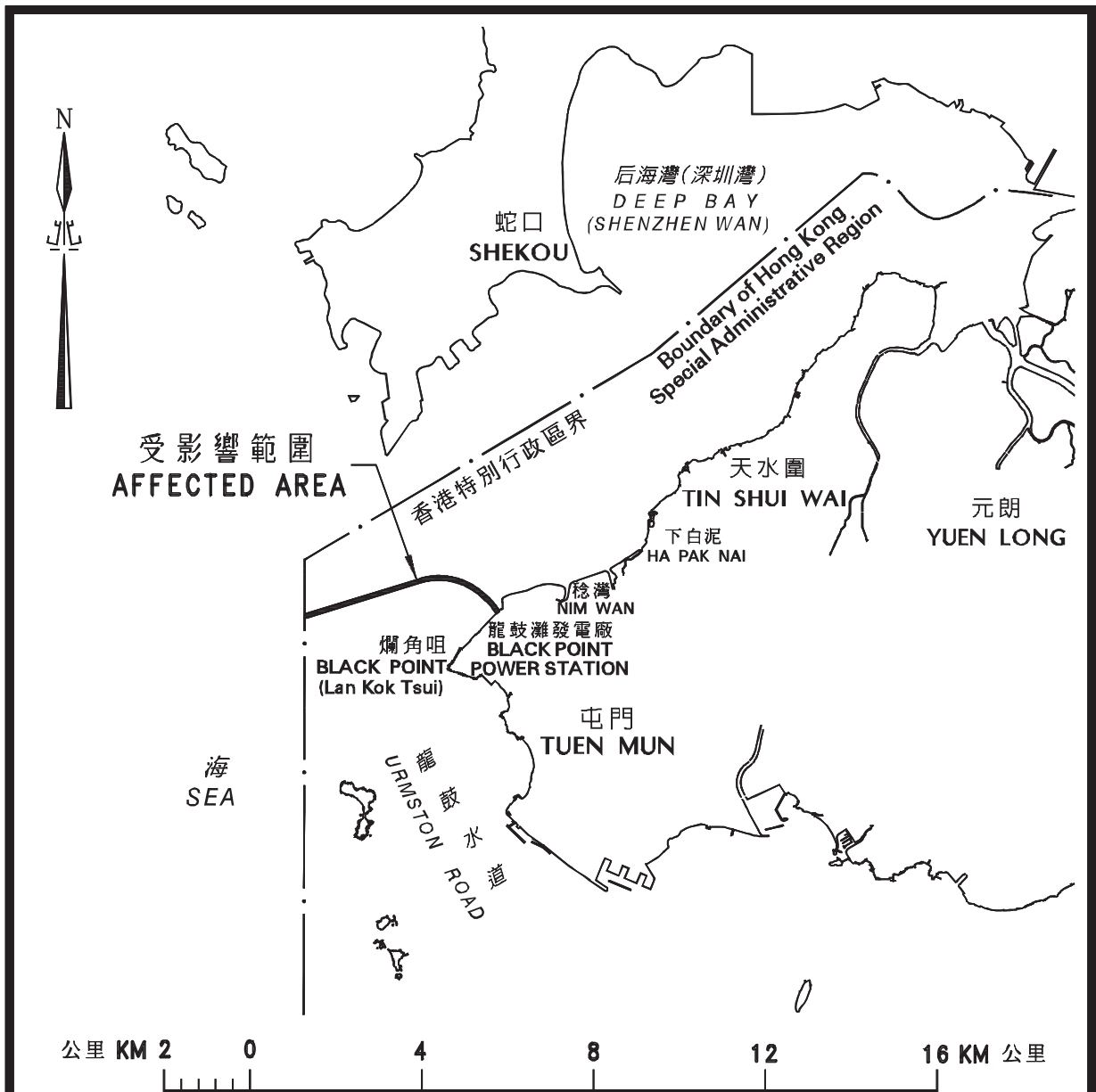
*Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking*

Installation of one submarine gas pipeline varying from 813 to 1 067 millimetres diameter and approximately 5 kilometres in length in HKSAR waters. The gas pipeline requires a trench (including works area) varying from 35 to 50 metres on either side of the centreline of the gas pipeline within the affected area. The gas pipeline will be installed using laybarge method, at a depth of up to 6.1 metres below the existing sea-bed level and be protected with 1 to 3 metres of armour rock and reinstated to the existing sea-bed level.

The area of foreshore and sea-bed affected is shown on the plan on the next page for identification purposes only. The area is more particularly shown on the plan numbered TMM3131 above referred to.
