MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY JORDAN STATION  
EXTERNAL LIFT

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Secretary for Development has made an order under section 10(1)(a) of the Ordinance authorizing the closure and substantial alteration of part of Jordan Road permanently from the 29th day of June 2010 (particulars of which are indicated on Plan No. KM8104 and listed in the table below together with the relevant details of such closure and substantial alteration) for the purposes of the construction, operation, maintenance or improvement of the Mass Transit Railway (‘MTR’).
