

## FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

KAI TAK DEVELOPMENT—KAI TAK APPROACH CHANNEL AND  
KWUN TONG TYPHOON SHELTER IMPROVEMENT WORKS

Notice is hereby given that the undertaking described in the Schedule below is proposed. Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over the foreshore and sea-bed so described may, by notice in writing delivered to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of two months from the date of this notice, object to the proposed undertaking. The notice of objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he alleges he will be affected.

## SCHEDULE

### *Foreshore and sea-bed affected*

Approximately 90 hectares of foreshore and sea-bed situated at Kai Tak Approach Channel, Kwun Tong Typhoon Shelter and in the vicinity of To Kwa Wan Typhoon Shelter as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered KM8188, deposited in the Land Registry.

*Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking*

- (i) Treatment of sea-bed sediments at Kai Tak Approach Channel and Kwun Tong Typhoon Shelter and improvement works to the embankments of the associated waterways and outfall of Kai Tak Nullah; and
- (ii) Demolition of disused dolphin in the vicinity of To Kwa Wan Typhoon Shelter.

The area of foreshore and sea-bed affected is shown on the plan on the next page for identification purposes only. The area is more particularly shown on the plan numbered KM8188 above referred to.
