It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 6711 published under section 5 on 30 October 2009 and 6 November 2009 was authorized under section 7 by the Chief Executive on 21 January 2010.

Approximately 1 100 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at Sham Shui Kok in North Lantau as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered ISM1791a, deposited in the Land Registry.	Removal of part of the existing sloping seawall and construction of a vertical seawall at the same location.
