(Notice of authorization under section 9)

PROPOSED NEW SUBMARINE GAS PIPELINE TO
BLACK POINT POWER STATION, TUEN MUN

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 2396 published under section 5 on 30 April 2010 and 7 May 2010 was authorized under section 7 by the Chief Executive on 11 October 2010.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 49.1 hectares of foreshore and sea-bed from the northwest boundary of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) waters to Black Point in Tuen Mun as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered TMM3131, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

Installation of one submarine gas pipeline varying from 813 to 1 067 millimetres diameter and approximately 5 kilometres in length in HKSAR waters. The gas pipeline requires a trench (including works area) varying from 35 to 50 metres on either side of the centreline of the gas pipeline within the affected area. The gas pipeline will be installed using laybarge method, at a depth of up to 6.1 metres below the existing sea-bed level and be protected with 1 to 3 metres of armour rock and reinstated to the existing sea-bed level.
