AMENDMENT TO CREATION OF RIGHTS OF
TEMPORARY OCCUPATION OF UNDERGROUND STRATA OF LAND

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has made an order under section 20(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') and section 46 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Chapter 1) directing that the rights of temporary occupation created by the order referred to in Government Notice No. 1050 dated 26 February 2010 be amended to the effect that in relation to the underground strata of land more particularly described in the first column below and between the levels specified in the second column below as shown coloured purple cross-hatched black on Plan No. RDM1211 annexed hereto which underground strata of land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 6865 published on 26 October 2007 and 2 November 2007, and as amended by Government Notice No. 6294 published on 12 September 2008 and 19 September 2008, and as corrected by Government Notice No. 135 published on 9 January 2009 and 16 January 2009, and as modified by Government Notice No. 1835 published on 20 March 2009 and 27 March 2009 and authorized by the Chief Executive in Council which authorization was gazetted in Government Notice No. 1835 published on 20 March 2009 and 27 March 2009, the period during which rights of temporary occupation of the underground strata of land have been created shall be amended as described in the third column below:—

Inland Lot No. 6356 (Portion); Inland Lot No. 6357 (Portion).	Between the level of 9.5 metres below Principal Datum of Hong Kong (which expression shall have the same meaning as in the First Schedule to the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Chapter 1) and is hereinafter referred to as 'P.D.') and the level of 28.5 metres below P.D.	From 27 March 2010 to 17 January 2011 instead of from 27 March 2010 to 31 August 2014.
