RESUMPTION OF LAND

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has made an order under section 16 of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that all those pieces or parcels of land known as:—

Kowloon Inland Lot No. 11098 (Portion); and

The Remaining Portion of Kowloon Inland Lot No. 10750 (Portions) (between the airspace at the level of 16.0 metres above Principal Datum of Hong Kong (which expression shall have the same meaning as in the First Schedule to the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Chapter 1) and is hereinafter referred to as 'P.D.') and the underground stratum at the level of 2.0 metres above P.D. (in respect of the portion in Shung King Street); and between the airspace at the level of 20.0 metres above P.D. and the underground stratum at the level of 2.0 metres above P.D. (in respect of the portion in Tak Ting Street))

as shown coloured orange hatched black on Land Resumption Plan No. RDM1283 (Sheets 1 to 2) annexed to the said order, which land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 7303 published on 27 November 2009 and 4 December 2009, and as amended by Government Notice No. 3671 published on 25 June 2010 and 2 July 2010 shall be resumed.

The above scheme has been authorized by the Chief Executive in Council and such authorization was gazetted in Government Notice No. 7669 published on 10 December 2010 and 17 December 2010.

This notice was affixed on or near the said land on 17 June 2011.

The Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has under section 18(1) of the Ordinance specified a period of notice of THREE MONTHS from the date upon which this notice was affixed on or near the said land and upon expiry of that period, the said land shall by virtue of section 18(2) of the Ordinance revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the scheme.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the date of resumption.
