RESUMPTION OF UNDERGROUND STRATA OF LAND

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has made an order under section 16 of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') directing that the underground strata in respect of the land more particularly described in the first column below and between the levels specified in the second column below:—

<i>Portion of the following Lot beneath which the Underground Stratum shall be Resumed</i>	<i>Depth of the Underground Stratum</i>
The Remaining Portion of Mass Transit Railway Lot No. 1	Between the level of 22.0 metres below Principal Datum of Hong Kong (which expression shall have the same meaning as in the First Schedule to the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Chapter 1) and is hereinafter referred to as 'P.D.') and the level of 25.0 metres below P.D.

as shown coloured blue stippled black on Underground Strata Resumption Plan No. RDM1241 annexed to the said order, which land was described in the scheme referred to in Government Notice No. 8022 published on 28 November 2008 and 5 December 2008, and as amended and corrected by Government Notice No. 2598 published on 30 April 2009 and 8 May 2009, and as modified by Government Notice No. 6682 published on 30 October 2009 and 6 November 2009 shall be resumed.

The above scheme has been authorized by the Chief Executive in Council and such authorization was gazetted in Government Notice No. 6682 published on 30 October 2009 and 6 November 2009.

This notice was affixed on or near the said land on 1 December 2011.

The Deputy Director of Lands/Specialist has under section 18(1) of the Ordinance specified a period of notice of THREE MONTHS from the date upon which this notice was affixed on or near the said land and upon expiry of that period, the underground strata in respect of the said land shall by virtue of section 18(2) of the Ordinance revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for the purposes of or incidental to the scheme.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing before expiration of one year from the date of resumption.
