DISTRICT COOLING SYSTEM AT THE KAI TAK DEVELOPMENT  
CONSTRUCTION OF SEAWATER INTAKE AND OUTFALLS  
AT THE FORMER KAI TAK AIRPORT RUNWAY

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 8599 published under section 5 on 19 December 2008 and 24 December 2008 was authorized under section 7 by the Chief Executive on 11 March 2009.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

## SCHEDULE

*Foreshore and sea-bed affected*

Approximately 975 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at the former Kai Tak Airport runway as delineated and shown coloured pink on a plan, numbered KM7724, deposited in the Land Registry.

*Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking*

To construct a seawater intake and an outfall at approximately the middle of the southern side of the former Kai Tak Airport runway and another seawater outfall at the northern end of the former Kai Tak Airport runway. The construction of the seawater intake and outfalls will involve demolition of the existing runway seawall and its reconstruction within the existing land portion. The intake and outfalls will be flush with the surface of seawall after completion.
