Notes

General

- 1. The applicant must be the occupier of the structure(s) with a clearance number issued by the LandsD in respect of the project concerned. If the project involves resumption of private land, the application may be submitted after the posting of the resumption notice. If the project involves only clearance of government land (i.e. resumption of private land is not required), the application may be submitted within 6 months prior to the first scheduled day of clearance.
- 2. If the application for early payment of the EGA is approved, the LandsD will offer a one-off full payment of the EGA to the applicant. Application for payment of the EGA by instalments will not be entertained.
- 3. On the date of departure, partial handover of the occupied site/partial vacation of the occupied structure(s)/squatter structure(s) will not be allowed. The applicant is required to hand over and vacate all of the occupied site/structure(s)/squatter structure(s).
- 4. To facilitate the LandsD's processing of the application, please submit the application

form together with copies of the following supporting documents of respective family member(s) registered in the Pre-clearance Survey ("PCS") (also known as the "Freezing Survey"). The LandsD may also require the applicant to provide other necessary information and documents as appropriate.

- a) Hong Kong Identity Card/Birth Certificate or other proof of birth;
- b) Certificate of Marriage (if applicable);
- c) Death Certificate of the spouse (if applicable);
- d) Proof of divorce and the order issued by the court for being granted the custody and the right to care and control of the child(ren) (if applicable);
- e) Proof of residential address (such as bills for water, electricity and telephone/mobile phone service, tax assessment/return notices, monthly bank statements, tenancy documentary proof, rental receipt, employment cards, employment contracts, employer's statement, documents or bills issued by government departments or public organisations, and other valid supporting documents).

#Please note: Applicants who live in a licenced domestic structure/surveyed domestic squatter structure must have continuous residence in the affected structure for at least two years preceding the date of the PCS, whereas applicants who live in a licenced non-domestic structure/surveyed non-domestic squatter structure must have registered in the Squatter Occupants Voluntary Registration Scheme and satisfied the requisite requirements of the scheme. If applicants who live in a licenced non-domestic structure/surveyed non-domestic squatter structure are already covered by a PCS but yet to receive compensation and rehousing arrangements, it is not necessary for them to submit a separate application under the above scheme. However, they would still be required to satisfy the requisite requirements by proving continuous residence in the non-domestic squatter structure since 10 May 2018 or before.

Purpose of Collection of Information

- 5. The personal data provided by the applicant in this form will be used solely by the LandsD and its authorised contractor(s) for processing the subject EGA application.
- 6. The provision of personal data in this form is voluntary. If the applicant fails to provide sufficient information, the LandsD (and its authorised contractor(s)) may not be able to process the application.
- 7. The LandsD (and its authorised contractor(s)) may, for the purpose of assessing and making payment of the EGA to the applicant, disclose the personal data provided by the applicant in this form to other government departments.

Access to and Correction of Personal Data

8. The applicant has a right under Sections 18 and 22 of and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance to request access to and correction of personal data. Such right includes the right to obtain a copy of the personal data provided in this form upon payment of photocopying fees and other necessary charges. The applicant is also entitled to request correction of the personal data if he/she considers them inaccurate.
