The electronic “A Book” is not public record and the information in it is intended only for the internal use of the District Lands Officers and staff of the Lands Department. Lands Department makes no representation or warranty as to the accuracy and correctness of the contents of the electronic “A Book” or the printed report (collectively “the Record”).

We confirm that the information is intended and will be used for our own reference only. We acknowledge that we shall be responsible for checking the relevant documents and up to date information by conducting a land search at the Land Registry or any other means and, if consider necessary, consult our own advisers for independent advice as to the accuracy or correctness of the contents of the Record.

We acknowledge and agree that the Government shall have no responsibility or liability to us or to any person for any loss or damage whatsoever and howsoever arising in connection with or in consequence of the existence or disclosure of the Record or any reliance placed or to be placed upon the information (including any updating, change, alteration, addition, deletion, revision or replacement of it) contained in or omitted from the Record.

We acknowledge and agree that the Government has the right to update, change, alter, add, delete, revise and replace any information contained in the electronic “A Book” at any time, whether before or after the date of this application, and in the manner as it considers appropriate. Notwithstanding anything contained in the PN and this application form, the Government is not obliged to and shall not be required to keep all the information contained in the Record up to date.

¹ If the Co-owner is a Tso/Tong, consent from the manager(s) shall be provided.

² If the Co-owner is a Tso/Tong and the manager(s) has passed away, a copy of the death certificate of such deceased manager(s) shall be produced if so requested.

We understand that the District Lands Officer has the absolute discretion to agree to or reject our application as he considers appropriate and if our application for obtaining a printed report of information in the electronic “A Book” (if applicable) is agreed, a fee for obtaining the printed report is payable as demanded by the District Lands Officer.

We expressly declare, confirm, acknowledge and agree that all the particulars, documents and information provided herein and in support of our application are true and correct in all respects. We have not withheld any information required in the application, nor have we provided any misleading information.
