TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Secretary for Development has made an order under section 10(1)(b) of the Ordinance authorizing the temporary closure and temporary substantial alteration of the part of Cheung Sha Wan Road from the 30th day of March 2012 until the 30th day of November 2014 (particulars of which are indicated on Plan No. KM8320 and listed in the table below together with the relevant details of such closure and substantial alteration) for the purposes of the construction, operation, maintenance or improvement of the Mass Transit Railway (‘MTR’).
