SHORELINE STABILISATION WORKS AT BUTTERFLY BEACH, TUEN MUN

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below as mentioned in G.N. 7560 published under section 5 on 18 November 2011 and 25 November 2011 was authorized under section 7 by the Chief Executive on 23 February 2012.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the Gazette, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

Approximately 2 890 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at the eastern end of Butterfly Beach, Tuen Mun as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered TMM3354, deposited in the Land Registry.	Shoreline stabilisation works at Butterfly Beach, Tuen Mun involving construction of an approximately 13 metres wide and 90 metres long rock revetment at the eastern end of Butterfly Beach to protect the existing beach facilities.
