

FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

(Notification under section 5)

CONSTRUCTION OF A LANDING AND ACCESS FACILITY AT CHE LEI PAI
BEACON, TOLO CHANNEL, TAI PO

Notice is hereby given that the undertaking described in the Schedule below is proposed. The notice of objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he alleges he will be affected.

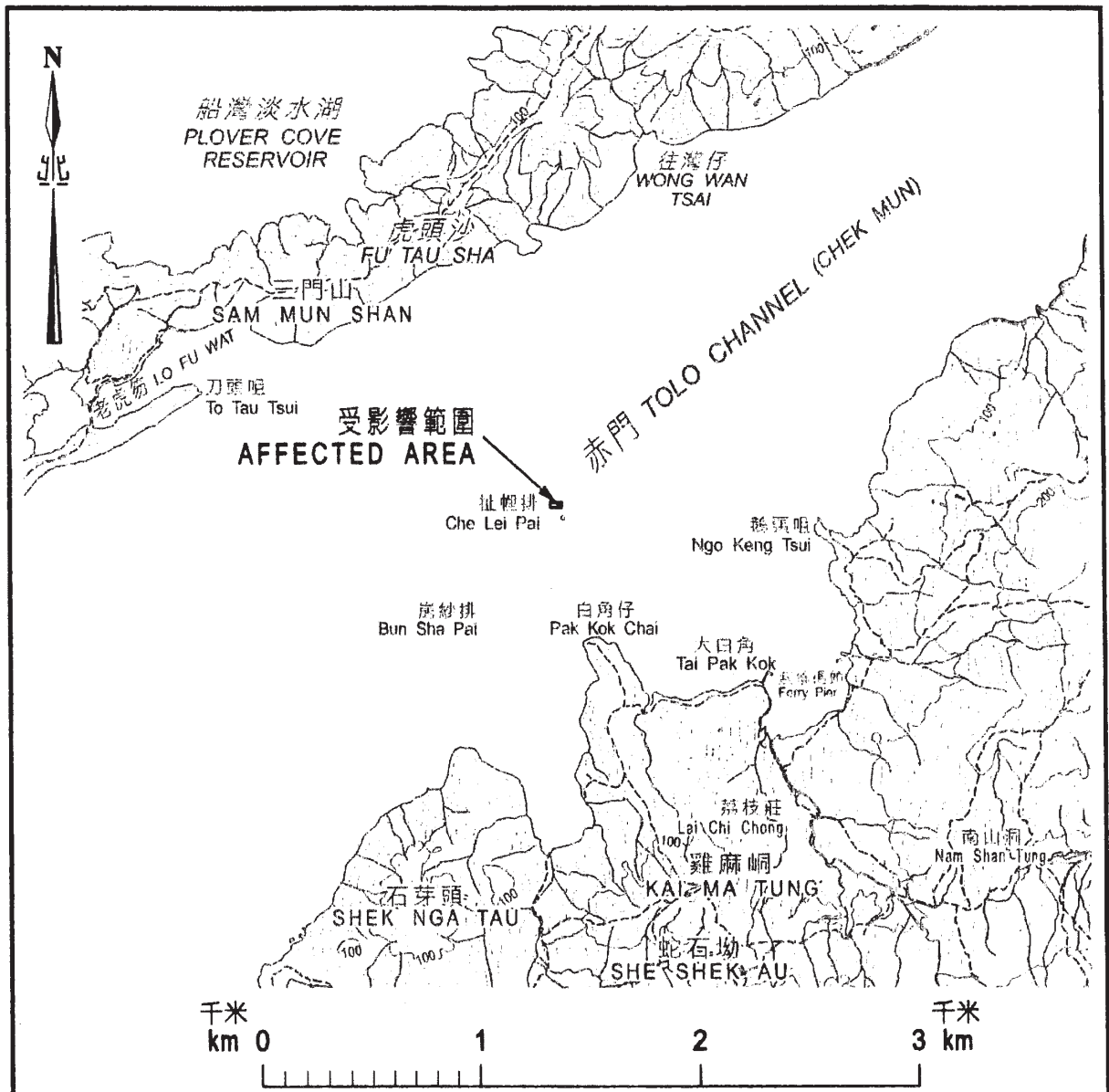

Approximately 1 270 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed situated at Che Lei Pai Beacon as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered TPM5441b, deposited in the Land Registry.	Construction of a concrete landing and access facility extending to 65 square metres (about) at Che Lei Pai Beacon to provide safe access for maintenance.
