

FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

(Notification under section 5)

PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAMME ITEM NO. 5114AP
PROVIDING SUFFICIENT WATER DEPTH FOR
KWAI TSING CONTAINER BASIN
AND ITS APPROACH CHANNEL

Notice is hereby given that the undertaking described in the Schedule below is proposed. Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over the foreshore and sea-bed so described may, by notice in writing delivered to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of two months from the date of this notice, object to the proposed undertaking. The notice of objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he alleges he will be affected.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 428 hectares of sea-bed situated at Kwai Tsing Container Basin and portions of Northern Fairway, Western Fairway and East Lamma Channel as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered KTM1492a, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

Dredging of the sea-bed to a level of approximately 17.5 metres below Chart Datum to enable unrestricted access for the new generation of Ultra Large Container Ships to the port facilities at the Kwai Tsing Container Terminals.

The area of foreshore and sea-bed affected is shown on the plan on the next page for identification purposes only. The area is more particularly shown on the plan numbered KTM1492a above referred to.
