

MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY (LAND RESUMPTION AND RELATED PROVISIONS) ORDINANCE
(Chapter 276)
(‘the Ordinance’)

MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY SHEK KIP MEI STATION
EXTERNAL LIFT

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Secretary for Development has made an order under section 10(1)(b) of the Ordinance authorizing the temporary closure and temporary substantial alteration of part of Woh Chai Street from the 1st day of November 2012 until the 30th day of November 2013 (particulars of which are indicated on Plan No. KM8192a and listed in the table below together with the relevant details of such closure and substantial alteration) for the purposes of the construction, operation, maintenance or improvement of the Mass Transit Railway (‘MTR’).
